

Student Advisory Trustee (SAT) Guidelines

- Must be in grades 9 – 12
- Must be a BPLD card holder
- Must be a Teen Advisory Board (TAB) Member
- TAB members interested must complete an application and turn it in by September 10, 2018
- Applications can be dropped off at the Youth & Teen Services desk or emailed to bpldteen@bartlettlibrary.org
- Top applicants will be invited to interview at the Board Meeting on September 17, 2018
- Term begins in October
 - Runs from October 1st – August 1st
 - Next applicants are interviewed and chosen at the September board meeting
- The SAT would be a non-voting position and will not be allowed to attend executive session
- SAT will report on items from TAB meetings at Board Meetings
 - Will have 2 – 5 minutes to present information
 - Aim to highlight at least 3 things about the last meeting
- SAT will share some highlights from the board meeting at the next TAB meeting
- SAT will provide written feedback to the Board, the Director, the designated Youth & Teen Librarian, Managers, and the TAB.
- SAT will receive an orientation packet
